Treasurer:	Club follows calendar year (December is year-end), 2020 had membership dues at a stasis (ie. people don't just sign up for events), decrease in expenses as no events were run, budget for 2021, modest approach, expected recovery over 2020,
Communications:	Puts out the monthly newsletter, and updates social media accounts. Website update was biggest project. All registrations will be completed through the site.
Learn to Ride:	Learn to Ride program was awesome this year. Jump Jam was a huge success with a ton of riders.
Mountain:	Early on was slow with independent events (Raven Rides) New jerseys, local artist collaboration Season ender, membership BBQ, celebrate back to events and social opportunities Looking to borrow timing equipment from other local organizations to support more events / races Relay race and kids race – kudos to Lynda Foreman
Pidherny:	Membership shows importance of Pidherny and the mountain bike community Adaptive flow trail, \$90,000+ raised, blue trail, thank our sponsors and donors Accessible facilities at the top parking lot Adjustments to the ridge trail Pidherny committee, responsibilities and requirements have increased, need more support to manage Pidherny, looking for members to help out Build nights 10-12 people helping out on average Ride nights, a lot of new faces, 6-13 people, refreshing to have social rides again Fire fuel mitigation plan by the City of Prince George, reducing forest fire risk, from Ditch Pig down, start in December or January, working with CPG and RSTBC to confirm impacts, affect winter use of rec site, logging trucks and crews working, reach out if you need more information

<p>Urban:</p>	<p>GBBW 20th Anniversary in Prince George, changed name to address where people work, it's more inclusive, changes to the provincial group Stepping down as Director, but looking forward to helping someone to help out GBBW coordinator is a paid position Bike swap was with the Caledonia Nordic Ski Club at Otway, allowed for bigger vendor trade show, met Covid regulations, raised a lot of money for the Urban account, a lot of fun with some great food trucks Bike Force is a new initiative, Liane and TJ spearheaded, fourteen people, ride bike lanes on a monthly basis to monitor, worked with Dave Bradshaw at CPG (Transportation Manager), provide feedback on improvements, received 24-48 hour response window, no grants received Leaving the position, passionate about biking, a lot of benefits of cycling</p>
